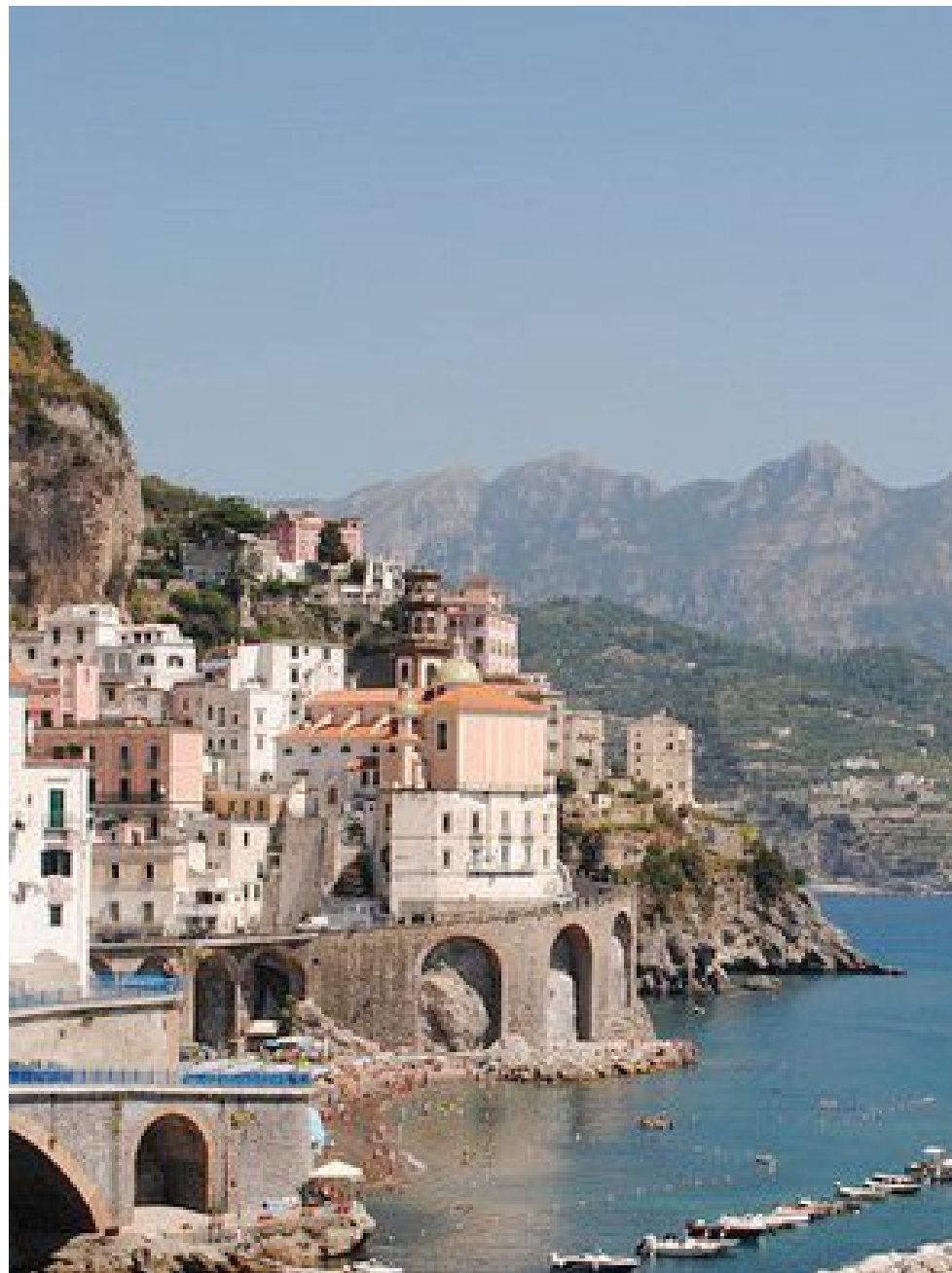

NAPOLI E DINTORNI: GREEN TOUR

Four days dedicated to nature lovers to visit Naples and its surroundings plenty of historical parks, panoramic gardens and green areas of great natural interest.

4 days and 3 nights.

DAY 1: Where the hill overlooks the coast

Collection at the arrival terminal and transfer by C4Y minibus to the hotel. After check-in we continue by minivan to **Piedigrotta** to enjoy the first views of Naples from the "bucolic" and mysterious **Vergiliano park**. Beside the plants there are detailed descriptions by Virgil himself taken from his works and Virgil's final resting place. We can eat 'neapolitan style at a typical restaurant along the street! There are breathtaking views of the Vomero hill and the enchanting gulf of Naples. A short c4y bus ride up to **Posillipo hill**. At the top of the hill we will have a two hours visit along panoramic virgilian park and After the visit a bio fresh herbal tea (tisana) and back to the hotel.

DAY 2: The Neapolitan Flora

After breakfast in hotel, meeting with our tour guide and departure by C4Y minivan for the ancient heart of the city: via Foria and Carlo III square and then a two hour visit to the **Botanic gardens**, a thirty acres really unsuspected oasis in the center of the town. We can eat 'fresh seafood at a typical restaurant along the street! In the afternoon a walk through the large **Capodimonte park** next to the royal palace where we'll admire Warhol and Caravaggio masterpieces! After a stop for a fresh herbal drink (tisana) and a breath! Back to the hotel.



DAY 3: Sorrento, the golden lemons against the blue of the sea

After breakfast in hotel, meeting with our tour guide and departure by C4Y minivan to Sorrento. This stage lead us to discover the enchanting **Agruminate**, the most famous garden of the Sorrento peninsula, a yellow and green spot in the middle of the city. Exiting this citrus grove you will be in the colourful centre of Sorrento, and we can stop for some lunch and shopping while travelling towards the lush **Villa Comunale**, where one of the most renowned sea views of Campania awaits us. The itinerary also includes visits to selected accessible museums and churches. Back to the hotel.



DAY 4: The private life of the Uphill Palace

After breakfast in hotel, meeting with our tour guide and departure by C4Y minivan for Vomero. The stage revolves around the visit to the refined Villa Floridiana, bought by the aged Bourbon Ferdinando IV for his beautiful consort, Luisa Migliaccio. Here we will learn about the most intimate aspects of court life, about affection and love, something so different from the mundane and majestic life of the Palace.

The homely, cozy, relaxing atmosphere also pervades the park, so green and refreshing with its Romantic style and the 150 different species of plant and its breathtaking panoramic view of Naples. We can stop for a biologic drink and rich vegetarian food! Shopping time with a personal shopper at the Vomero center! Back to the hotel or to the transport terminal station.

DAY 5: The upside-down Mountain (Extention)

After breakfast in hotel, meeting with our tour guide and departure by C4Y minivan for towards Astroni, one of the best preserved craters of the Campi Flegrei volcanic area and now a Nature reserve owing to its large variety of flora and fauna. After this we return to the transport terminal station.



NAPLES AND ITS SURROUNDINGS: TOUR ARGENTO

DAY 1: The bastions between the sea And the green Chiaia Park

Meeting at arrival terminal – transfer by accessible c4y minivan to hotel, from where we begin an itinerary designed to give visitors an idea of how Naples has evolved and how its coastline has been transformed over the years. Naples’ historical passion for maritime trade and seamanship is also made evident, remnants are explored which provide testimony to numerous hard-fought waterfront battles, in which Naples’ legendary bastion fortifications not only defended the royal court and its noblemen, but also many local merchants. These bastions, **Maschio Angioino e Castel dell’Ovo**, were extremely powerful, well-equipped, and able to blast an impressive amount of munitions throughout the entire gulf. We can fortify ourselves with a hearty lunch and a strong, Neapolitan coffee and a scenic bus ride along the seaside to Victoria square a stroll along the seaside and through historic **Villa comunale**, the Chiaia park where we can see the three ages of this park from ‘royal promenade’ to ‘park of the people’. After this we return to the hotel.



Four days dedicated to elderly people: enjoy Naples at all ages! Music, dance and entertainment !guided cultural visits to the most well-known monuments and places.
4 days and 3 nights.

DAY 2: The Royal Palace of Capodimonte and its park

After breakfast transfer by minivan to enjoy a stroll along the wide tree-lined avenues of **Capodimonte park**. One hour of light exercise (Qi Cong - yoga) in the fresh air oin the gardens pof the park and a short visit to the royal palace with its Caravaggio masterpieces and Farnese collection. A stop for a gourmet neapolitan meal! in the afternoon after a neapolitan coffee we are ready to go! transfer by minivan to Municipio square where now, after a recent archeological dig, it is possible to admire the remains of the ancient roman harbour. a short visit to either the **Royal Palace or San Carlo Teatre** in the impressive vast p.zza Plebiscito. Crossing the square we can go for a nice stroll along via Toledo with to admire its noble townhouses and for a spot of shopping. Back to the hotel.



DAY 3: Up and downn aboard old and new carriages

After breakfast in hotel back to the starting point in via Toledo by c4y minivan. Now let’s zoom up Vomero hill, aboard the historic augusteo funicular railway, for a visit to the refined, villa ‘Floridiana’ royal country residence where we will enjoy the cosy relaxing atmosphere which pervades its romantic gardens, its breathtaking panoramic views over the Riviera di Chiaia and the Mediterranean sea below. A nice stroll along the nice shopping streets of Vomero where we can stop for lunch! In the afternoon we head down to the centerby the new metro to visit its ‘art’ stations defined as the most beautiful in Europe, because of the juxtaposition of antient riuns and avantgarde works by contemporary artists. Back to hotel.

DAY 4: The Historic Center with the decorative tiles and nativity statues

After breakfast in hotel, we l visit the Duomo, fover linked to the mysterious miracle of the liquification of the blood of San gennaro, the patron saint of Naples. After this by c4y minivan we’ll go along the intricate central network of ancient dark alleyways up to San Gregorio Armeno where craftsmen sell figurines of the nativity shepherds. Back to the transport terminal station.

NAPOLI AND SURROUNDINGS: THE THREE BURNING SOULS OF CAMPANIA FELIX

DAY 1: Hilltop Panorama

Collection at the arrival terminal and transfer by C4Y minibus to the hotel. After check-in we continue by minivan heading straight for one of Naples' most spectacular viewpoints. From the panoramic terrace of San Martino and the monastery of the same name we find ourselves perched above the rooftops and cupolas of the city. The entire Bay of Naples can be seen from here, not to mention the majestic Vesuvius in the distance and the historic Spaccanapoli thoroughfare, splitting the city, quite literally, in two. Back to the hotel.



DAY 2: Enjoy Ischia at a Glance

After breakfast we will reach Ischia in an hour and 40 minutes by ferry, a must for any tourist. We will be taken to discover this magnificent green island, its volcanic craters and its thermal baths, renowned for the quality of water that still demonstrate a slumbering, but still entirely evident volcanic activity. Ischia is the largest Island in the Gulf of Naples and is known as 'green island' on account of its lush vegetation, its landscape of extraordinary beauty and of postcard-perfect scenes set against a relief of flowers, hot

Ischia - Campi Flegrei - Vesuvius, related by the presence of volcanic craters, represent the three fiery souls of Campania, known throughout the world for their health spa springs, the breathtaking landscapes, the rich vegetation and the historical and archaeological sites. Campania felix is so called because of its fertile land, as regenerated by the many eruptions. Since ancient times it has been a holiday resort for its wholesome air and Mediterranean cuisine appreciated all over the world. 4 days and 3 nights.

springs and bubbling mud baths, a famous cure for all kinds of ailments. In the morning we will go through the six communes of the Island, Ischia, Casamicciola Terme, Lacco Ameno, Forio, Serrara Fontana and Barano and for lunch can taste fresh pasta, limoncello and the spicy peperoncino. We will have a chance to buy the noteworthy colourful ceramics that adorn every angle of the island. Back to hotel in the late afternoon.

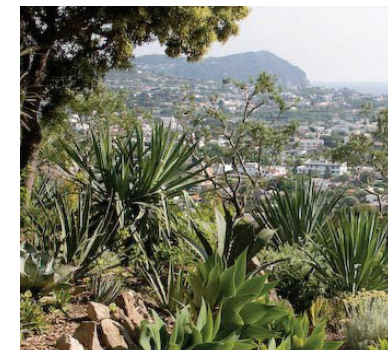
DAY 3: The Flegreian Fields: the Phenomenon of Bradisism

Breakfast, meeting with tour guide and departure for the Flegreian Fields, a vast volcanic zone located to the North-West of Naples. At least twenty-four craters and other volcanic phenomena are still recognizable today, the most famous of which being Solfatara. In this ancient volcanic forum we can still witness (and smell!) sulphuric emissions, fissures and explosions of boiling mud. Adding a seismic dimension to the volcanic, we are confronted with the peculiar phenomenon of Bradisism: a slow and continuous rising and falling of the ground level that over the years has transformed the landscape of Pozzuoli. Lunch break. In order to better appreciate the seismic upheavals of the area, we visit the Temple of Serapide, followed by a host of other ancient ruins that bear witness to the historic and mythological importance of this special place. We can do a bit of shopping too, of course, in the charming centre of Pozzuoli town. After that, it's time to go back to the hotel.



DAY 4: Vae Suis, You wanted Vesuvius. Here is the real thing

After breakfast, our minibus will whisk us off to Vesuvius. The road to the summit starts here: it is winding and suggestive and littered with all manner of small shops and farms, selling authentic products from the area, such as Lacrima Cristi wine and Caprettone. When we finally reach the top we will be blown away by a view unlike anywhere else on Earth. Thus concludes the tour.



VESUVIAN AREA: VILLAS AND THE 'IDLENESS' BETWEEN NAPLES AND VESUVIUS

DAY 1: The Liberated Waterfront

Collection at the arrival terminal, transfer by C4Y minibus to the hotel. From here we already begin to enjoy the unparalleled splendor of Naples' unique landscape. Its praises have been sung by numerous poets and musicians over the centuries and it continues to enchant many more. The route starts from the port area, dominated by the Castel Nuovo and the Castel dell'Ovo and their surrounding ramparts, and then on to the Parthenope promenade, which has recently been pedestrianized and returned to its former glory as one of the most beautiful walks in the world, leading up to the famous Via Caracciolo and to the foot Posillipo Hill. From there, we head back to our hotel in the Vesuvian area.



The lands that lie at the foot of Mount Vesuvius have for millennia been elected as places of holidays and the 'bon repos' of the wealthy and aristocratic classes of ancient Rome up to the time of Bourbons. Coming down from Vesuvius and in stark contrast to its abundant nature, we will visit the ancient villas of the buried cities by the eruption of 79 AD, to get to stroll along the tidy parks and historic gardens and magnificent views of the coast of the eighteenth century Vesuvian villas; the visitor can relive the relaxed spirit of these places and taste the sweet atmosphere described by the Romans as 'the idleness'. 5 days and 4 nights

DAY 2: Vesuvius: Nature to Explore

After breakfast, the minibus will take us to Herculaneum. Along the route up to the volcano Vesuvius, you can see the first railway that led to the National Park. Drive along one of three of Vesuvius trails the scenic trail to Monte Somma. Stop for lunch in one of the many agritourisms in the area in order to sample products such as the wines Lacrima Cristi and Caprettone, the tomatoes, rustic bread and other typical products of Campania Region. In the afternoon we visit the MAV museum to measure, in a virtual way, the explosive power of the volcano. Here we also get a first glimpse of life of the local inhabitants in Roman times. Back to hotel in the late afternoon.

DAY 3: Roman Villas Buried By The Eruption In 79 Ad And 18Th Century Villas.

After breakfast, the minibus will take us back to Herculaneum, this time to visit the excavations of the nearby ancient Roman city of the same name. Lunch nearby. Here we have the unique opportunity to compare the Vesuvian Villas of Herculaneum with the 18th Century grandeur of the villas of Portici's so-called Golden Mile. After that, back to the hotel for dinner and bed.



DAY 4: Pompei and Torre Del Greco

Breakfast in the hotel precedes our obligatory visit to the legendary ancient city of Pompei, famously destroyed by the eruption of Vesuvius in 79 AD. From here we then enjoy lunch in a local restaurant. After lunch, the tour proceeds to Torre del Greco, whose bay area, with spectacular views of the island of Capri, is considered, truly, one of the world's most picturesque. The historic centre gives us another chance to admire a few of the area's finest Vesuvian Villas, such as Palazzo Petrella, and to soak up the unique charm of this elegant town. Thus concludes the tour.

DAY 5: From the Greeks to today: historical, layers of history in the centre of Naples:

Breakfast in the hotel, meeting with guide and departure by C4Y minibus to Piazza del Gesù a few steps in the alleyways of the historic centre, and the original main streets of Naples: i Decumani. From here we continue to Santa Chiara Monastery, famous for its Maiolic Cloisters. To finish off, we take a look at the famous street of nativity scene art, San Gregorio Armeno, before visiting the Duomo di San Gennaro. Lunch during the excursion, plus free time for shopping. Transfer to the departure terminal, end of tour.

Five days of tasty, traditional recipes and cooking tips, admiring, between restaurants and gourmet supermarkets, the natural beauty and unique sights connected to historic and cultural events in the life of the city. Delicious menus for all tastes taken from the best of Neapolitan Cuisine, from the classic Neapolitan Pizza, spaghetti alle vongole, the famous ragù, aubergine parmigiana and irresistible sweets and pastries. **5 days -4 nights**

DAY 1: Seafood menu in front of the sea

Arrival in Naples and transfer by accessible minivan to the hotel. Appointment with guide and departure for a panoramic tour along the seafront, now a traffic-free zone. Visit to Castel dell'Ovo (from where arises the legend of the birth of the city and the mermaid Partenope). From here we proceed to Possilipo hill to take in a view without equal. On the way back, a mere stones' throw from the hustle and bustle of the city's shopping area, we will sample a seafood menu, right in front of the sea itself. After which, we return to the hotel. Buon appetito!



DAY 2: Home restaurant experience

After breakfast, early departure towards the heart of Naples. Among the sights and sounds of the Pignasecca market stalls, we will select first-hand products of the finest quality, with the help of our cook, who will later prepare the evening meal. We proceed then to a visit to monasteries and churches and a brief stroll through the alleyways of the historic centre. A first taste of street food: potato croquettes, rice balls, fried pizza, babà and sweet treats. In the afternoon we visit the Cathedral of San Gennaro, the city's patron saint. At 1900, it's time to go to Valeria's house, where we will eat both healthily and heartily. Return to hotel.

DAY 3: Let's learn how to cook 'pizza' !

After breakfast, departure with the famous accessible minivan for a trip to Vomero Hill and the San Martino Terrace, to take in the Bay of Naples in 360 degrees, framed by Vesuvius, with the entire city sprawled below. From here we visit Saint Elmo Castle and the adjoining monastery complex. We take a pit-stop for street food and herbal tea in this charming residential area before heading back down towards the port, where we will spend the afternoon in an enogastronomic centre, learning the art of Real Neapolitan Pizza. To finish... take your places to sample the fruits of our labours! Then: back to the hotel.

DAY 4: Potato croquettes, rice balls, fried pizza, baba and 'sfogliatella'.

After breakfast, departure for a tour, taking in various stops along Naples' Metropolitan Line 1, transformed into unexpected museums thanks to the intervention of celebrated architects and contemporary artists. Leaving the underground at Via Toledo, we can treat our eyes to the historic townhouses of this avenue, and can treat our mouths to the street food of the nearby Spanish Quarter. In the afternoon we visit the fortified Castel Nuovo, followed by the Royal Palace. In the evening we dine in a traditional tavern to the characteristic strains of traditional Neapolitan music. Return to the hotel.



DAY 5: a sweet souvenir!

After breakfast, departure for a guided underground tour of the Galleria Borbonica beneath Naples where we'll experience a historical journey to retrace 4 centuries of the history of Naples and admire remains dating back to the fascist period as well as cars and motorcycles. Before leaving do not forget to buy a pack of typical sweets to take with you with the smell of memory. Transfer to the departure terminal. End of services.

NAPOLI: NAPLES BETWEEN SACRED AND PROFANE COURTYARDS AND CLOISTERS

DAY 1: Churches and Monasteries of the historic centre

Collection at the arrival terminal, transfer in the C4Y minibus to the hotel in Naples, where the tour operator will greet us. Departure by minibus for the historic centre of Naples, where we will find an exceptional concentration of historic churches and monasteries, flanked by the grand palazzi of the Neapolitan nobility. A number of famous streets run through the heart of the city. Known as decumani and dating back to ancient times, the most significant of these streets is Via Tribunali, where we will have the chance to visit the monumental complex of Pio Monte della Misericordia or to try out some street food for lunch. The afternoon brings us to the Church of San Lorenzo and its adjoining museum, at the very core of the old Greek city. Here we also find San Gregorio Armeno, another celebrated monastery that lends its name to an equally celebrated street of artisan workers. In the evening: back to the hotel to relax.



The route shows the contrast between the worldly and the sacred aspects of Naples life through the centuries, yet vivid and well represented by the great palaces of the nobility and by the churches and convents that are concentrated in the historic center and in particular in its oldest center. The route offers many opportunities shopping items of high craftsmanship and exclusive brands. 4 days and 3 nights.

DAY 2: Palaces and Palazzi

After breakfast, the C4Y minivan will bring us to Piazza Carità, where we will start our walk along the famous Via Toledo. Enter the courtyards of the various townhouses or palazzi that line this shopping thoroughfare and compare it to the rough-and-ready charm of the Spanish Quarter. Of particular note is a visit to Palazzo Zevallos di Stigliano, today housing the art collection of the San Paolo banking group. Here we can see what is regarded as Caravaggio's final masterpiece. The tour continues to Piazza Trieste e Trento, where, after a spot of window shopping, we can enjoy an aperitif in the classy confines of Galleria Umberto I. For lunch, a taste of the famous pizza fritta (fried pizza). The afternoon is dedicated to the twin jewels of the San Carlo Opera House and the Royal Palace. From here we continue to the gardens that lead towards the port, with ships large and small moored in the shadow of Vesuvius. From there, back to the hotel, dinner, bed.

DAY 3: Townhouses of Chiaia

Breakfast in the hotel. The C4Y minibus is already outside, waiting to take us the elegant zone of Chiaia for Naples' most refined shopping experience. Also here we can enjoy the architectural diversity of the city, with its charming courtyards and unusual details. An unmissable example of Neapolitan Liberty (Art Nouveau) at Palazzo Mannajuolo. Walking along the seafront we arrive at Villa Pignatelli, site of a unique mansion-museum. After that, lunch. In the afterno-

on, a quick visit to the Villa Comunale precedes an appreciation of Piazza dei Martiri with the baroque courtyards of Palazzo Calabritto and Partanna. From there we find ourselves at Via Chiaia for another spot of shopping. There will of course be more beautiful courtyards to see, in particular, those of Palazzo Celamare and Palazzo Miranda, before we find ourselves at the spectacular Piazza del Plebiscito. In the evening, back to the hotel for dinner and a well-deserved rest.

DAY 4: Back to the old Centre

Breakfast in the hotel and transfer by minibus to the centre. At Via Monteoliveto we encounter the renaissance convent complex of Sant'Anna dei Lombardi and the renaissance courtyard of Palazzo Gravina, currently the home of the Faculty of Architecture. A quick drive in the minibus later and we find ourselves at Via Mezzocannone for a guided tour of the Paleochristian Church and monumental church of San Giovanni Maggiore. Transfer back to the transport terminal. Thus concludes the tour.





NAPOLI E DINTORNI: PINK TOUR

DAY 1: The Ancient Center: The Lives Of Abbesses, Artists, Painters And Pagan Goddesses

Meeting at arrival terminal – transfer by accessible c4y minivan to hotel, and before continuing by c4y minivan to Piazza del Gesù. Here we visit Santa Chiara Monastery, famous for its maiolic cloister. Following the historic Decumani streets we go towards piazza Miraglia, where it's possible to admire Chiesa di Santa Maria Maggiore La Pietrasanta Church, built in the VI secolo on the remains of a secret roman temple of the Goddess Diana. In this area there are plenty of opportunities to try street food. In the afternoon we stroll through the artist district of Naples (p.zza Bellini, Via Costantinopoli and piazza Dante) where we can find traces of the lives of various women artists such as painters and musicians who lived above all between the 19th and the 20th centuries..Back to the hotel.



Partenope the city of women : four days dedicated to women, beauty and entertainment Tales and legends of Neapolitan ladies , protagonists of history for the Ages!

4 days and 3 nights.



DAY 2: Breathaking Mediterranean Views, Majestic Monasteries And Royal Escapes: Lives Of Queens, Royal Mistresses And Brothels.

After breakfast a stroll from the old stock exchange ‘ piazza della Borsa’, along via Toledo , a peek into the spanish quarters, on to piazza plebiscito and a visit to the Royal Palace of Naples. A stop for a ‘neapolitan meal ! After lunch a short c4y bus ride up Vomero hill passing through a verdant landscape dotted with lovely 19th century neapolitan villas and early 20th century liberty style architectural masterpieces. At the top of the hill we will have a three hours to visit the san Martino certosa (Carthusian monastery) and the Villa Floridiana (royal bourbon country residence).Back to the hotel.

DAY 3: The Ancient Stories Of Saints , Mermaids And Revolutionary Educators

After breakfast in hotel, now we go to downtown Naples on Mount Echia, where Palepoli was founded, overlooking the Megaride rock where the legendary mermaid Partenope died. Down again to the seafront for a stroll along via Caracciolo, Riviera di Chiaia and pedestrian ‘lungomare liberato’. Here we can stop for lunch at one of the many restaurants. In the afternoon visit at either the Pan Museum, or villa Pignatelli or Castel dell’ovo. Back to the hotel.

DAY 4: Shopping time!

After breakfast transfer by C4Y minivan to the shopping area with a personal expert shopper! Walking along via de’ Mille for perfume shops, fashion boutiques, artisan clothing, local artwork and souvenirs. A bus ride along the harbour area and through downtown Naples. a stop at Maritime Station for a glance at the ships and at the adjacent shopping center. One last coffee and a traditional cake and back to the hotel to pick up the luggage! Transfer by bus to trasport terminals.



NAPOLI: NAPLES AT A GLANCE TOUR

DAY 1: A warm Welcome!

Meeting at the arrival terminal – transfer by accessible city minivan to hotel and then we continue by minivan for a scenic bus ride along the promenade, a must for every tourist visiting Naples. We pass by the famous Castel dell'Ovo, with Vesuvius behind; it's connected to the origin of the city and to the myth of the mermaid Partenope. After a walk along the pedestrian 'Liberated seafront', we will pass by minivan through Via Caracciolo with a stop at villa Pignatelli on The Riviera di Chiaia to admire its treasures of paintings, sculptures, old horse carriages, pottery and gardens. The tour will then continue towards the hill of Posillipo to enjoy the most unforgettable views over the bay and out on to horizon. Back at the hotel to have dinner and a good night sleep!



Four days to visit Naples and get a taste of its history, enogastronomy and of the beautiful scenery of the city and its surroundings.

5 days and 4 nights.



DAY 2: The eagle over the hilltop

After breakfast we take a panoramic bus ride up to the top of Vomero hill and San Martino square for our first 360° view of the imposing Vesuvius, the city and the bay at its feet; then a visit to saint Elmo castle where we can reconstruct the whole history of the city. Next to the Castle is the San Martino Monastery and we will visit its beautiful museum complex. Here we can stop for a delicious traditional Neapolitan meal! In the afternoon we will visit the historical centre of Naples with picturesque alleys and millennia of history; UNESCO World Heritage site. Visitors can have a stroll through the open air museum and can pick up unique gifts from the artisan shops along the way, of particular interest is San Gregorio Armeno a street famous for its nativity scene model makers. The center is filled with baroque churches and fascinating religious complexes (such as the famous cloister of Santa Chiara). Then over to the Duomo, the Cathedral of Naples forever linked to the mysterious miracle of the liquefaction of the blood of San Gennaro, the patron saint of Naples. Back at the hotel for dinner and bed.



DAY 3: A journey in time from virtual to real

After breakfast, departing from Naples, we will lead visitors to the discovery of Herculaneum, one of the archaeological sites destroyed by the eruption of 79 A.D. An experienced guide will help us relive the thrill of walking through the streets of an authentic Roman city, reading the inscriptions left by the inhabitants and reconstructing their ways of life. Time to eat! In the afternoon we visit the MAV, the virtual archeology museum for a trip through time, taking the visitors to the ancient Roman cities at the foot of the Vesuvius – the lively, commerce-centred Pompeii and the pleasant, refined Ercolano.
